

HOW DO I KNOW WHEN THE CITY OF MINNEAPOLIS DECLARES A SNOW EMERGENCY?

> Call 348-SNOW (7669)

TTY callers can use MN Relay Service or call 673-2157

> Go to www.minneapolismn.gov

Or Google "Snow Emergency Minneapolis"

> Watch local TV news or City Cable TV

Channel 14 or 79, or listen to the radio

> Go to www.minneapolismn.gov/snow

Sign up for a text message, email alert or phone call and the city will notify you when a Snow Emergency is declared.

> Look up where to park

> Download the Snow Emergency App

Works on iPhones and Android devices

Snow Emergency 3 Day Rule:

> Day 1: 9pm – 8am (overnight)

Snow Emergency declared no later than 6pm, rules begin at 9pm

DO NOT park on a Snow Emergency routes

DO park on both sides of streets that are not Snow Emergency Routes

> Day 2: 8am – 8pm

DO NOT park on the EVEN SIDE of streets that aren't Snow Emergency routes

DO park on the ODD SIDE of streets that are not Snow Emergency routes

DO park on either side of streets with the Snow Emergency route signs

> Day 3: 8am – 8pm

DO NOT park on the ODD SIDE of streets that aren't Snow Emergency routes

DO park on the EVEN SIDE of streets that are not Snow Emergency routes

DO park on either side of streets with the Snow Emergency route signs

> If it's FULLY PLOWED, you're good to park there.
